DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

WITHDRAWALS AND DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES

No entries may be withdrawn and no refunds will be given after closing on August 30, 2024.

"Day Of" entries will be offered if pre-entry limits have not been met and/or if time allows. Entries received after closing on August 30, 2024 at 12 pm CST will be considered a "Day Of" entry and additional fees will apply. Cost of "Day Of" entries is \$40.00 per test.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Sign-In

There will be a secretary table for check-ins and information inside the club house. This is also where ribbons and awards will be picked up.

Crating and Seating

There will be limited indoor crating available. Participants should plan to crate out of their vehicles. Chairs/seating are not provided. Participants should plan to bring their own chairs.

Spectators

Please note: Spectators will be allowed in designated areas.

Refreshments and Food

Food for Judges and Volunteers only.

Exercise /Potty Area

There will be a designated marked potty area at the SOUTH end of the parking lot. Do not potty, or Exercise dogs in any other location. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems Exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Test Time Slots

There will be specific "test time slot" based on level testing, etc. You must check in at least 30 minutes prior to your assigned test time. You will not be allowed to test earlier than your time slot unless the tests are running earlier than anticipated.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season are NOT eligible to participate in this AKC FETCH test, and should not be on the test grounds.

ENTRY FEES & ENTRY PROCEDURE

NOTE: Pre-entries must be received no later than August 30, 2024 by 12pm CST. No entry will be considered valid unless both a signed entry form and payment have been received. Online entries will be the fastest/easiest method to ensure your entry has been received prior to the closing date and time. Entries received after closing date and time will be considered a "Day Of" entry and be subject to additional fees.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The hosting AKC FETCH Judge and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The hosting AKC FETCH Judge and their committee reserve the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the hosting AKC FETCH Judge, their committee or any official thereof.

COLLARS, HARNESES and LEASHES: Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather or biothane. No retractable/Flexi leashes allowed on the test grounds.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except while actively testing. Dogs must enter and exit the test area with the leash attached to the collar.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the test area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: Please check in at the Secretary Table. **Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.**

RIBBONS: Please collect your Qualifying and New Title ribbons at the ribbon table.

PHOTOGRAPHY: There will NOT be a professional photographer at this event. Ringside cellphone photos and videos are allowed, but please take precautions to not distract the working teams.

FOOD SERVICE: We will not have food service for exhibitors at this event. Please bring your own food and water. **Food is prohibited in the spectator areas.**

TO BE ANNOUNCED

SPECTATORS: This is an outdoor event, spectators will be allowed in designated areas only. No dogs will be allowed in spectator areas.

Any claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

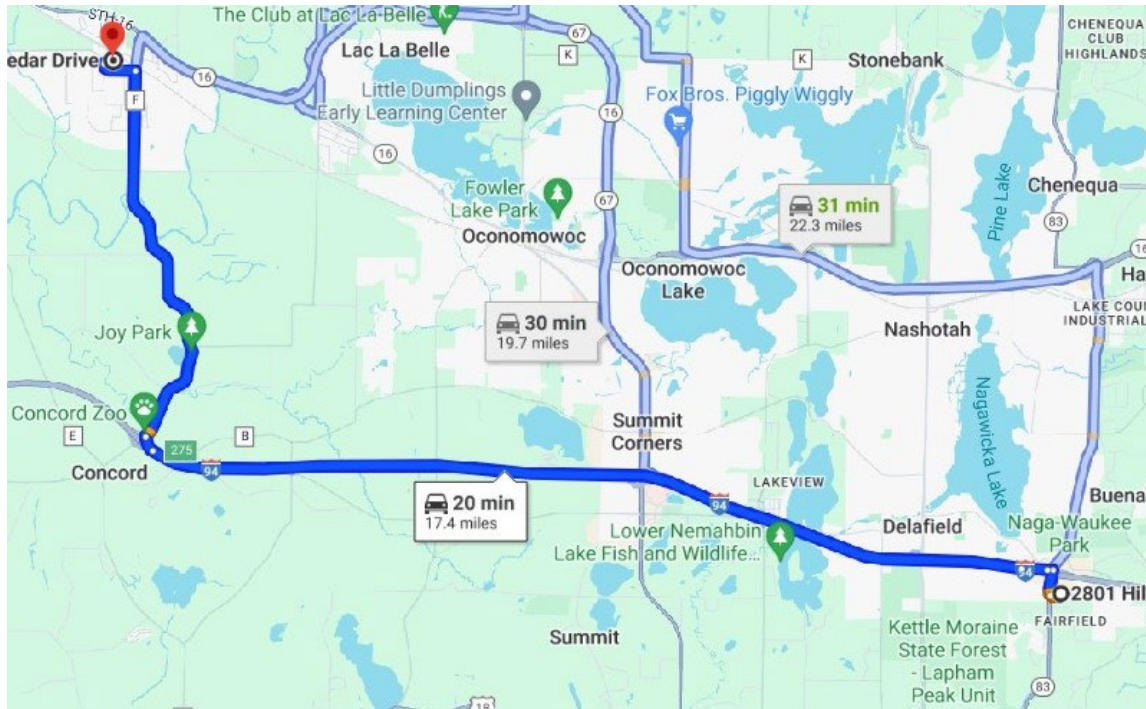

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

From I-94, exit #275 Cty F, Ixonia/Sullivan. Go North on Cty F about 4 miles. Turn West/left on Elmwood Dr./Cty P (just before the train tracks). Turn Right on Cedar Dr. Our building is at the end of the drive on the left.

Important: If you are coming from the East on I-94, do not get off at Exit #295 (County Hwy F in Waukesha Co).

Continue travelling west to Exit #275 – Cty F in Jefferson Co. From the East, take Hwy 16 about 5 miles west of Oconomowoc. Turn South on Cty F (Ixonia). Turn Right on Elmwood/Cty P, first right after train tracks. Turn Right on Cedar Dr. The building is at the end, driveway on the left.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
